This year, ALL plastics can go in the recycling - including soft plastics.

This includes;

- » sweets outer wrappers (looking at you, large tin of shiny chocolates!)
- » wrapping paper & bubble wrap (for those delicate gifts)
- » Take-away plastic containers (after we've all spent too many days eating Christmas leftovers)

All materials must be CLEAN, DRY and LOOSE before being placed in the recycling bin.



Things that DON'T go in the recycling include:

- » Glass (local bottle bank)
- » Batteries and bulbs (free at WEEE recycling points)
- » Nappies and wipes (general waste)
- » Food waste & garden waste (compost / food bins)
- » Clothes & shoes (clothes bank or charity shop)
